

From the Pastor

May 2025

"He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen. Come, see where his body was lying. And now, go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and he is going ahead of you to Galilee." (Matthew 28:6-7a)

My wife and I have just begun the tedious process of packing as we anticipate our move into retirement status. It's a daunting task that can be physically and emotionally draining. While sorting and packing boxes my mind begins to wander to what will happen after the boxes are unpacked. What will my life look like as I begin a new role as a retired pastor? What's next on the horizon?

What's next? I'm sure that was what all the disciples wondered when they first heard of the resurrection. The disciples weren't fully prepared for what would happen after Good Friday. It was a shock to lose their rabbi that they had followed for three years. . . and the way that they lost him — to the horrible death of Roman crucifixion. Then, that Sunday morning the women came and told them that Jesus wasn't dead in the tomb. What a shock and yet joyful news. But what next?

The women were also told that Jesus was going on ahead of them to Galilee. So maybe they weren't left without direction after all. So, the disciples make the trip to Galilee. I'm sure it was a long one as they wondered if the story of his resurrection were really true, and if they would really see Jesus.

The resurrection story that we celebrate on Easter Sunday is a story of surprise and confusion and then hope. Like the disciples who first heard the news we may have mixed emotions at Easter. We certainly love to hear the songs of praise that we sing on Easter Sunday, "Christ the Lord is Risen Today." We like to feel the energy and share the springtime excitement with others. We like to hear again that we need not fear death, but we also may wonder, "What's next after Easter Sunday?" "What's next for my life now?"

In the account in Matthew we see that once the disciples get to Galilee says that they do see him and they worshipped him, and some still doubted. And the disciples get their final instructions.

"Go to the people of all nations and make them my disciples. Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to do everything I have told you. I will be with you always, even until the end of the world." (Matthew 28:19-20 CEV) So, that's what we are to do. That's what's next.

Like the disciples in that we often have mixed reactions to twisting turns of life. Sadness one minute, joy the next, and most of the time we just seem to bumble along not sure where to turn next. But as disciples of Jesus we are given instructions to help us move forward as Easter people, as followers of the risen Christ. We are given a mission. We are to follow the way of Jesus and help others hear the story and help them become followers too. Jesus says "make them my disciples" and "teach them everything I have told you." That's our "What next."

As fellow followers who worship together and sometimes have our share of doubts about the future, may we be faithful in carrying out the Easter message of hope as the church. And may we always remember that Jesus promises to be with us "even to the end of the world."


Children's Sunday School, Preschool - 12th Grade

2025 Susquehanna Annual Conference

The theme for the 2025 Susquehanna Annual Conference session is "Believe... and see the Glory of God." SUMC delegates attending the May 29th-31st annual conference in Williamsport this year are Pastor Jon Buxton, Cindy Biesecker, and Marianne Wolf.

The 2020/2024 General Conference passed several proposed amendments to the Constitution of the United Methodist Church. These unique pieces of legislation can only become official if they are ratified by at least two-thirds affirmative vote of the aggregate members to the annual conferences. The results will not be known or announced until after all 127 United Methodist annual conferences in Africa, Europe, the Philippines, and the United States have voted. The four amendments to be considered are:

- Carrying out the restructuring plan called "regionalization"
- Expanding inclusiveness in church membership
- Standing against racism and colonialism
- Clarifying who can vote for clergy delegates

To provide information on the proposed changes and hear input from our members, the delegates will be holding two listening sessions (10:45 and 11:30am) in the Social Hall on Sunday, May 4th.

We are also collecting items for Mission Central Activity Kits. Our district has been assigned scissors (round or pointed) and 12-inch rulers of metal, wood, or plastic (must include both inches and centimeters.) Donations may be made in the Narthex through May 25th.
