



Sunday School Classes for Children & Adults 10:30 – 11:30am






Children's Sunday School Classes Sundays 10:30-11:30 AM

Acolyte Schedule


New Acolytes will be scheduled for fall. Check in at Sunday for the Acolyte schedule for October.

Good News Ringers: (Handbells 6th grade through Adults) Tuesday 6-7:00PM


God's Handful: (Youth Choir grades 6-12) Sundays from 11:30-12:15PM
